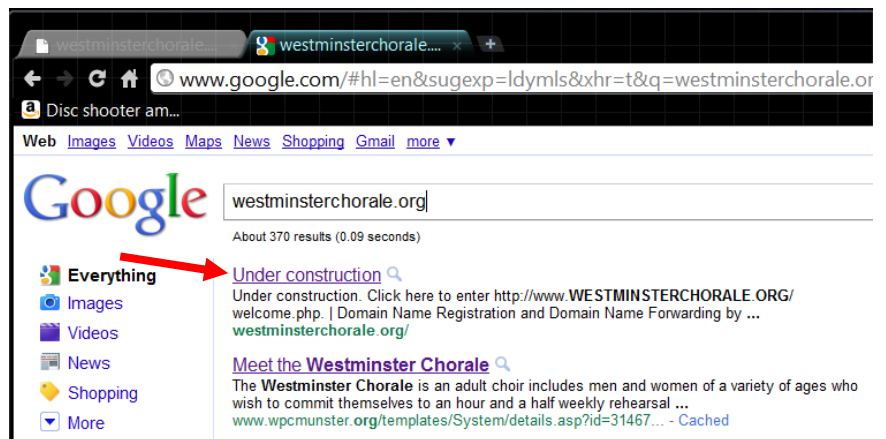


If anyone had troubles downloading the Mp3 audio practice files so they could save it to their Ipod or Mp3 player when using Google Chrome, here is how I did it:

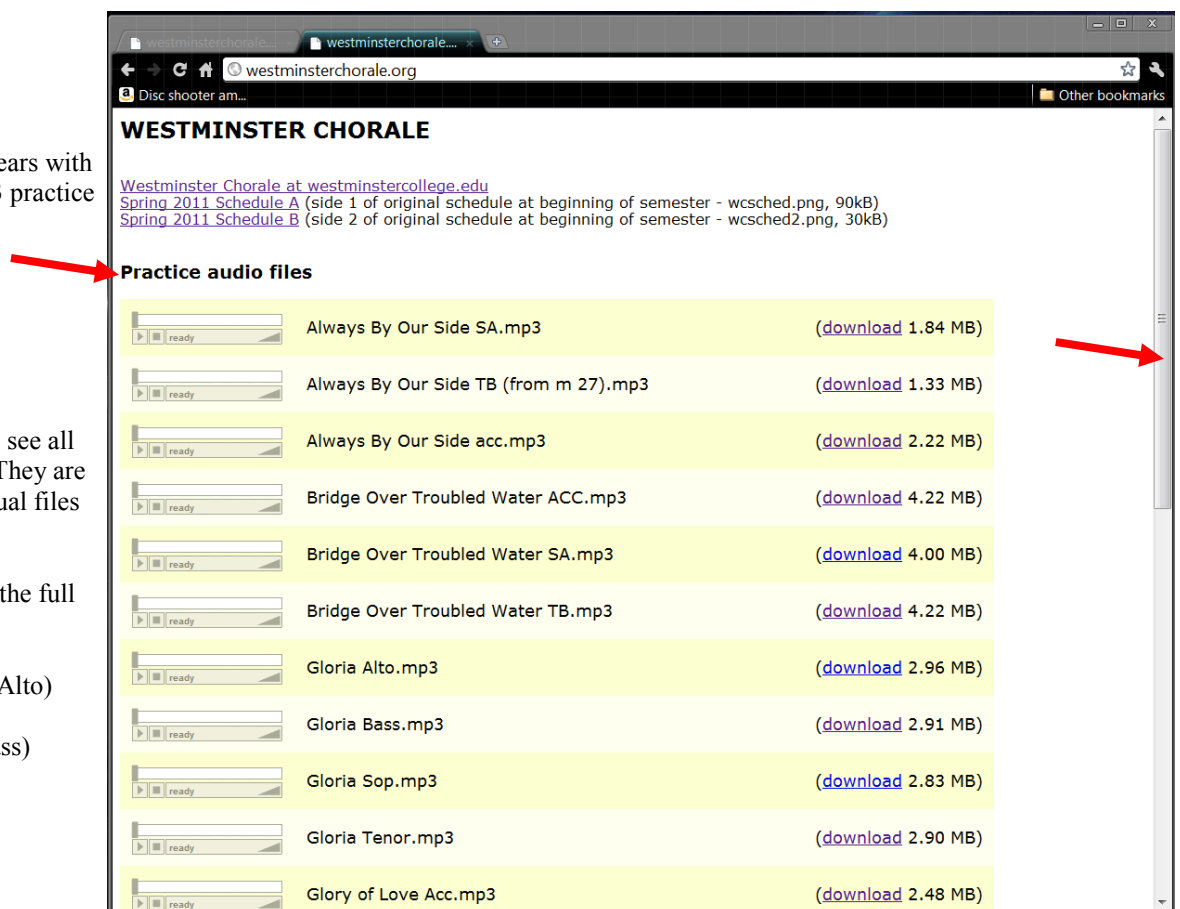
- Go to Google search page and type in: westminsterchorale.org.



- Select the website that says Under construction.



- A menu screen appears with a list of all the .mp3 practice audio files:



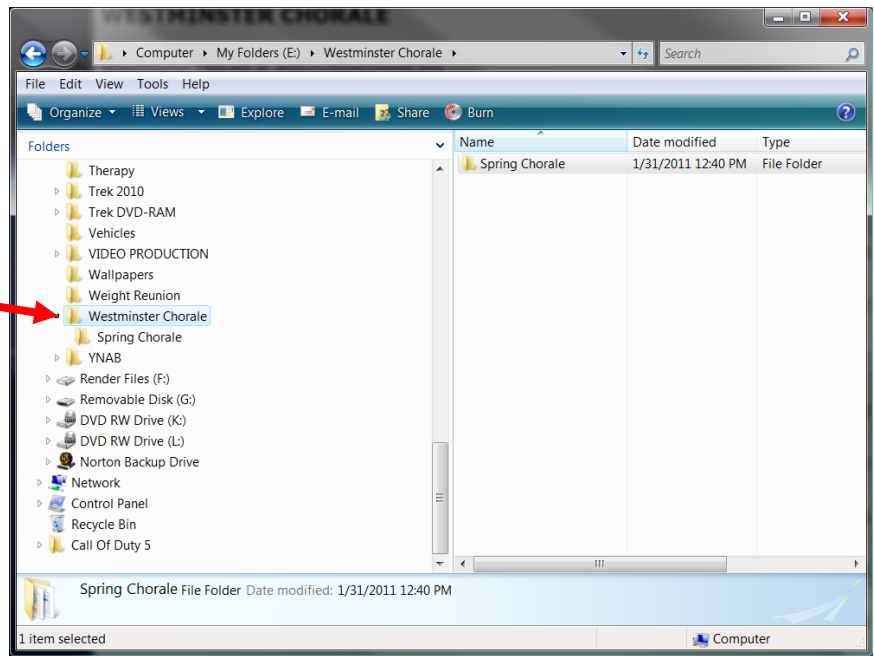
- Bar up and down to see all the files available. They are broken into individual files listed as:

Acc.mp3 (which is the full accompaniment.

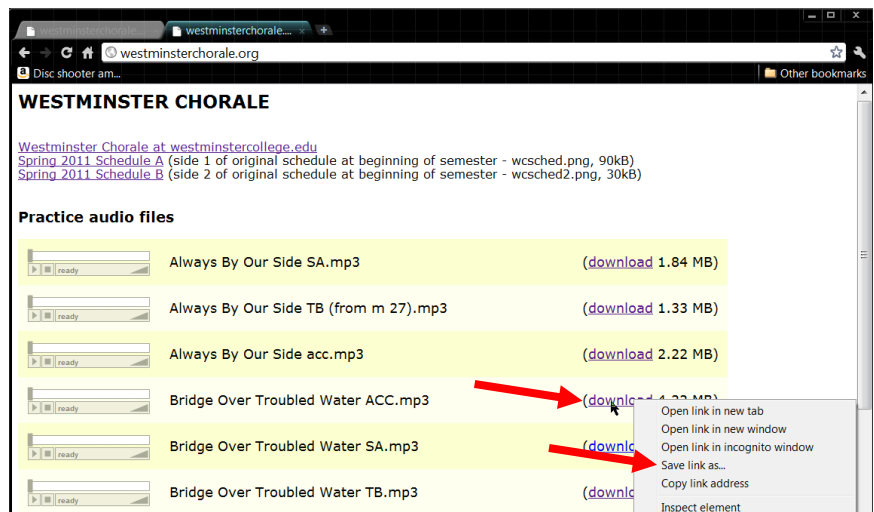
SA.mp3 (Soprano, Alto)

TB.mp3 (Tenor, Bass)

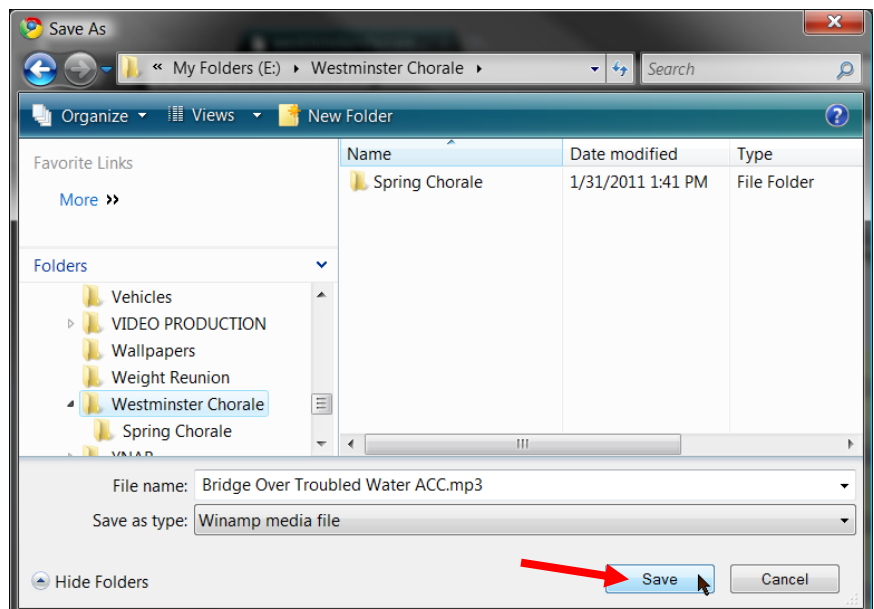
- Create a folder somewhere on your computer that's easy to find and remember to save the .mp3 music files to.



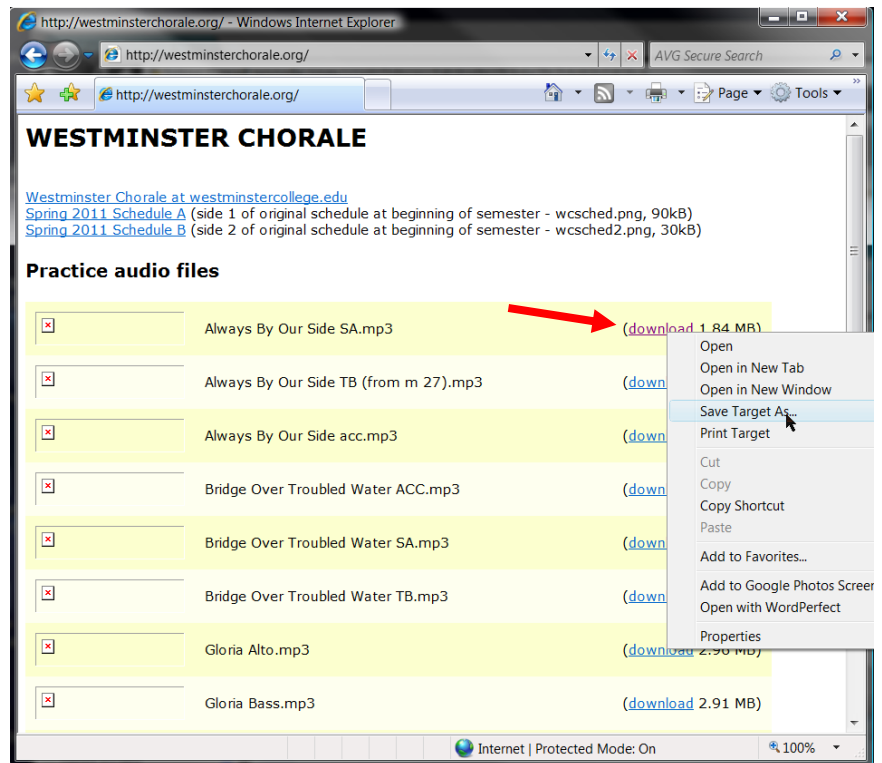
- Hover your cursor over the download line of the music you want to download then **right-click** the mouse. A choice of actions appears.
- Choose and click the Save link as...



- When the Save As window appears, navigate to the folder you created to save music in. You will see the File name:
- Click the Save button.
- You have saved the first file to your music folder. Go to the rest of the files and save each music file pertaining to your section.

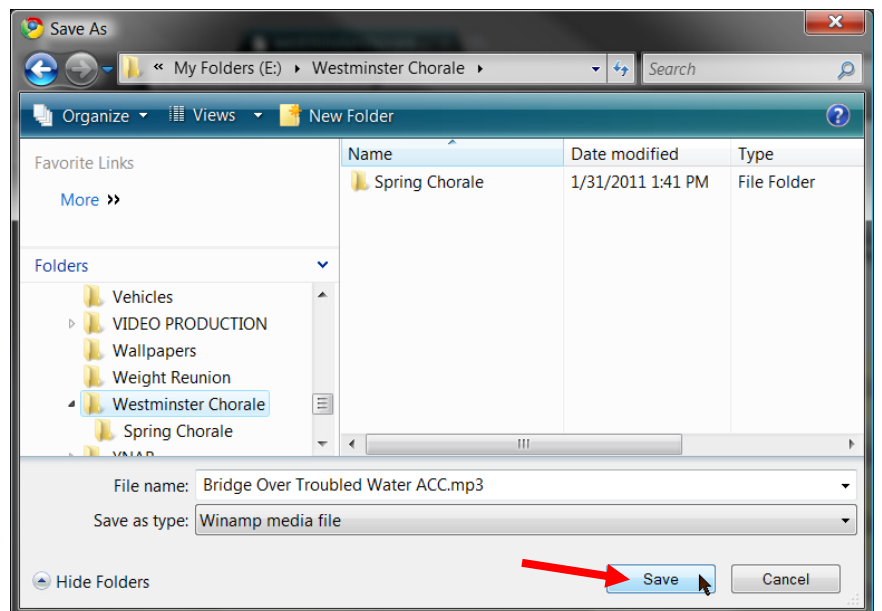


- If you are using Windows Internet Explorer, bring up Westminsterchorale.org Hover your cursor over the download line of the music you want to download then **right-click** the mouse. A choice of actions appears.



- Choose and click the Save Target As...

- When the Save As window appears, navigate to the folder you created to save music in. You will see the File name:
- Click the Save button.
- You have saved the first file to your music folder. Go to the rest of the files and save each music file pertaining to your section.
